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PARTICIPANT COMMITMENT

Dear Parent/Guardian:

We are delighted that your child will be attending the OASC Spring Conference May 2 & 3 at the Eugene Hilton. We want students to have a great time, but not at the expense of others. Because we wish to ensure the safety of your child, as well as other participants and hotel guests, we have developed the following guidelines:

- 1 Attend all conference sessions at the designated times and places.
- 2 Students are not allowed to leave the hotel at any time without their advisor or adult supervision.
- 3 For safety and liability reasons, students are not allowed out on the balconies AT ANY TIME!
- 4 Members of the opposite sex are not allowed in each other's sleeping rooms, unless the advisor is present.
- 5 Use of alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs is strictly prohibited.
- 6 Observe the conference-stipulated curfew (11:30 p.m.) All students MUST remain in their own rooms after that time.
- 7 Students should always dress and dance in an appropriate manner.

A violation of any of these guidelines could result in your child being sent home, and the principal being notified. Of course, we would much prefer that everyone has an exciting and safe conference!
